

SELECTBOARD MEETING MINUTES

Business:

Meeting commenced at 7:00 PM.

Discussed the Mill Creek bridge/culvert replacement and the relocation/upgrades of the winter salt/sand pile. Federal, state and local grants need to be applied for as soon as possible. Angus King & Susan Collins' offices are accepting letters of intent for these kinds of projects.

The town is still in the running for a \$50,000 grant from the Governor's Community Action program.

Bailey asked about the status of the septic systems identified in the DEP/DMR follow up survey associated with the Carpenter Cove shellfish harvest closure. Hatch explained that Don Baker is on the case and that work will resume in the late spring/summer.

The Maine IF&W has delisted the bald eagle as an endangered species. Bald Eagles are now recognized as a State Species of Special Concern.

The horseshoe crab is now listed as Threatened & Endangered.

The Castine Community Health Center is looking into what they may be able to provide to residents of Penobscot.
