Bryce reported that Maine DEP and DACF (Forest Service) will come to Penobscot to walk the McB property with her to follow up on concerns of unpermitted development and violations on Wednesday 6/28. Rapp will attend.

Bailey attended the Hancock County Planning Commission meeting earlier this afternoon. He reported that the entire meeting focused on the regional housing shortage issue.

Hatch will check with Bowen & Son Disposal regarding temporary rental of steel storage containers to hold construction debris and metal materials at the transfer station while site work takes place. Grimmel is coming to remove the metal pile soon. Hatch contacted Casey McGraw to have Joe extract freon from the appliances prior to Grimmel getting to site.

Hatch will move the speed/radar trailer to the fire station on Thursday.
