Caroline Yoder has scheduled a tour of the Castine transfer station this Friday. Board signed the Municipal Valuation Return.

Board obtained original documents dating back to October/November 1969 which indicate that the Town of Penobscot was pursuing a permit to fill a wetland for a public turnout on SR 175 (Carpenter Cove). Prior to this, Chris Haley had informed the Board that the turnout was owned by Margaret Holland and him (Map 23, Lot 21). Rapp will research and contact Haley & Holland.

Discussion took place as to why there are 21 bundles of shingles stacked in the parking area of the town office, left over from the roof work. Rapp commented that the original Dorr estimate of 37 squares seemed excessive. Rapp will measure the square footage of the roof and report back.
