To the Residents of Penobscot:

As another year has passed, we have been extremely busy. Penobscot's tax maps have now been updated and can be viewed at the Town Office.

Penobscot has finalized the purchase of what we call the Winslow Stream property. With a special donation from Maine Coast Heritage Trust we were able to purchase a small piece of property east of the Winslow Stream property.

Weather permitting, the majority of Penobscot should see high speed internet being put on poles around town by the time this report is printed.

Penobscot has several active committees working on things such as the Comprehensive Plan, climate change and sea level rise.

A special town meeting was held in December to adopt two new ordinances. The PACE ordinance allows low income families to apply for low interest loans for home weatherization. The other was an ordinance to help protect Northern Bay from large commercial aquaculture leases and businesses.

On behalf of the Town of Penobscot, the selectboard would like to thank all of the volunteers that make our community as friendly and special as it is.
